



WARC Events Timeline

The WARC Event Policies were developed in 2004, and subsequently reviewed in 2007 in an attempt to bring some kind of similarity and order into the running of WARC events. In accordance with the WARC Events policy tenders for the position of the Event Organiser shall open at least five months prior to the event, with elections to be held at the subsequent WARC business meeting. In the occurrence that no Event Organiser has been appointed three meetings prior to the event, the event may be cancelled at the discretion of the WARC Executive.

To make it easier for the forward planning of WARC Events, the below table has been developed. This should be used as a guide only. Event organisers can be called for and elected prior to this time; however this is the latest that it can happen.

All tenders shall be put to a vote of the WARC at a business meeting and be elected by a simple majority as stated in 4.5 (c) of the WARC Constitution.

The exception to this is the position of Bush Baja Chairman which shall be elected as deemed necessary by the WARC Executive. The other exception to this will be the position of the Mission Impossible (or major event held in its place) Chairman.

Gravel Moot	Late July	February	March

Rover Ball	Mid August	February	March
Bush Baja	Late September	As deemed necessary by the WARC Exec	
Quokka Moot	Date Differs	6 months prior	5 months prior

The above dates have been developed to exceed these guidelines with nominations being called for 6 months prior and elections 5 months prior to the event.
