CAMS Level 2 Non Speed license application/renewal process

Khanacross to be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, and the National Competition Rules of CAMS.

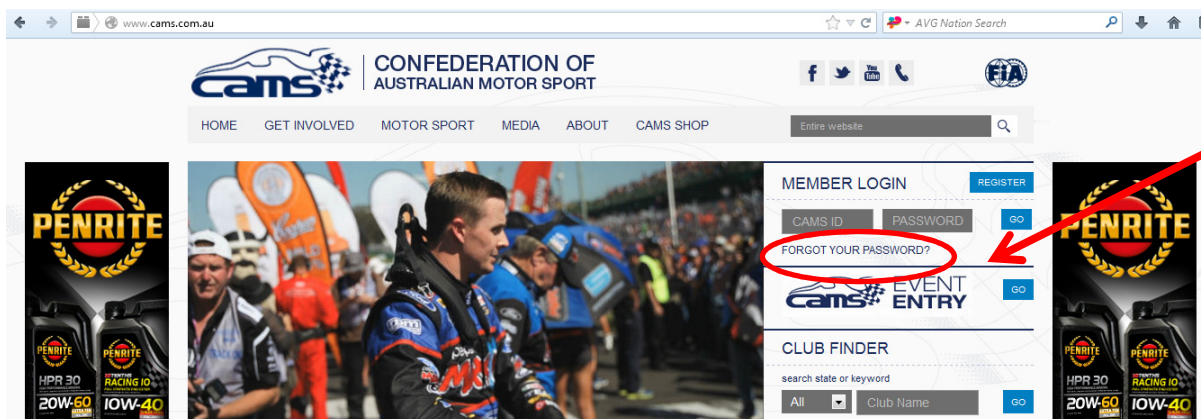
This document will detail how to register for the CAMS online portal, which will allow you to apply for or renew your L2NS license online for use at WA Rover Scout Motorsport events. Please note that from 2014, RSM WA will not accept paper license applications unless absolutely necessary and by previous arrangement with the President only.

Once you have a CAMS online portal account, you can log directly in and apply or renew your license, view expiry dates, and update your personal information.



IF YOU HAVE HELD A CAMS LICENSE PREVIOUSLY:

1. Access www.cams.com.au
2. Click 'FORGOT YOUR PASSWORD'



3. Enter your CAMS ID (your license number, located on your most recent license sticker) and your email address (which must be the same as the email address you used on your original license application when you first got your license. This email address will be listed on your most recent license sticker you received from CAMS).

If you do not know your CAMS ID or email address (e.g. you lost your license), call CAMS on 1300 883 959.

Alternatively, you can apply for a new CAMS member portal account to allow you to apply for a license, however you will need to re enter all your information and you will have a different CAMS ID. The preference is for you to maintain your original ID if possible and only open a new account if you cannot access your original account.

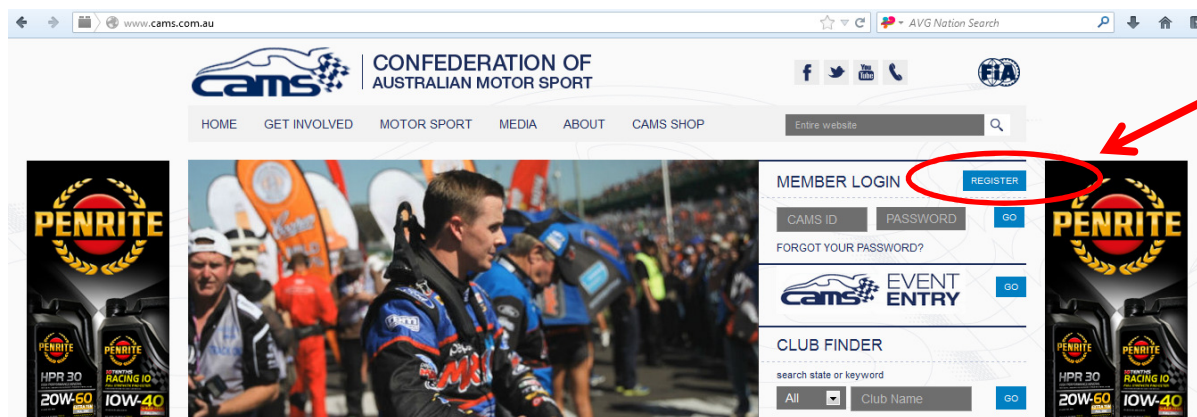

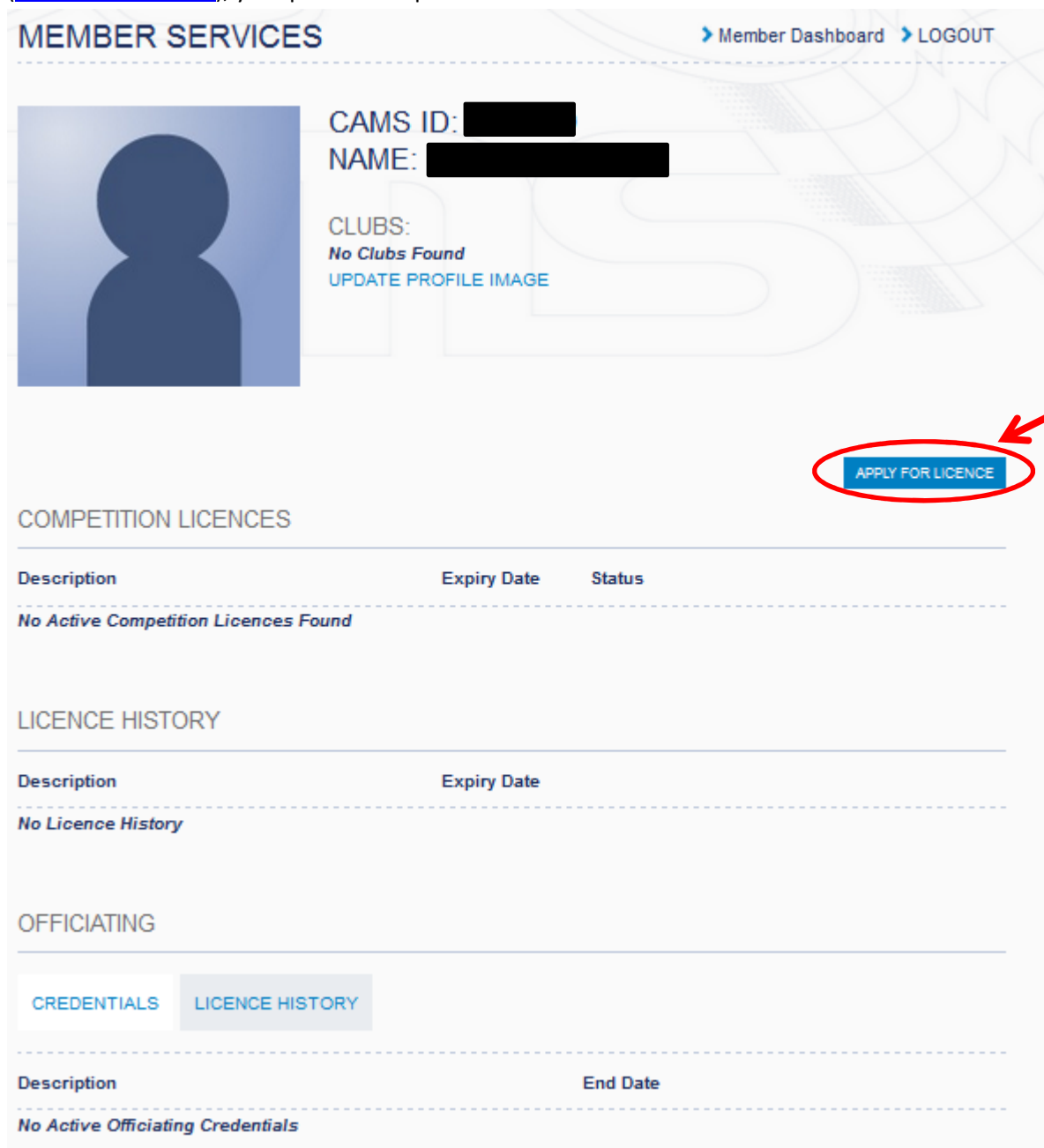

Ensure you select 'Level 2 Non Speed' as your license type.

On the PAYMENT screen, you will be asked if you want to pay a \$10 AIMSS levy. This levy is not mandatory so you can choose whether you pay it. This levy relates solely to a fund providing resources to motorsport safety and you will not receive anything extra or additional if you do pay it.

- You will then be prompted for credit card payment. The license fee is \$65 per year and it is your responsibility to renew it if expired before attending motorsport events.

Once you have applied for or renewed your license, CAMS will mail you your license logbook and license sticker. This can take over a week at times so make sure you do this well in advance of any event.

This is the process for obtaining a L2NS license only. You still need to submit your participant entry, vehicle entry, CAMS official trainee license and RSM WA membership forms to event administration.
